April 27, 2016

A regular meeting of the Plymouth County Commissioners was called to order at 8:30 a.m. at the County of Plymouth Administration Building, 44 Obery Street, Plymouth, MA. Present were Chairman Daniel A. Pallotta, and Commissioner Sandra M. Wright. Commissioner Gregory Hanley was unable to attend the meeting. Chairman Pallotta called for the Pledge of Allegiance.

Also, in attendance were Register of Deeds John Buckley, Treasurer Thomas O'Brien, Deputy Treasurer Jeff Welch, 4-H Director Molly Lipper, Superintendent of Buildings Doug Wedge, County Administrator Frank Basler, and Executive Assistant Nancy O'Rourke.

Meeting Minutes -March 25, 2016

Chairman Pallotta requested the approval of the meeting minutes be tabled to the next meeting due to Commissioner Hanley's absence.

Chairman Pallotta requested the discussion to approve the temporary to permanent hiring of Dennis Bradford and Paul Curran be tabled to the next meeting.

Commissioner Wright made a motion to accept and approve the hiring of temporary full time custodian Cameron Macedo for 60 days. Chairman Pallotta seconded.

Letter of Commendation-Captain James Hillman

Administrator Basler presented for the Commissioner's signatures, a Letter of Commendation for Captain James Hillman of Pembroke on his recent retirement from the United States Navy.

Vote-30 day extension-Plymouth County Municipal Vehicle Bid

Commissioner Wright made a motion to extend the current contract for 30 days such that the term will now end on May 30, 2016. This extension will allow the vehicle

dealerships time to coordinate any increase in pricing by vehicle manufacturers per the contract extension requirements. Chairman Pallotta seconded.

#### Vote-Award Bid for Re-indexing Services for the Registry of Deeds

Chairman Pallotta made a motion to accept the bid proposal of ACS Enterprise Solutions, LLC, (XEROX), 7030 Fly Road, East Syracuse, NY as the most responsive and responsible bid proposal offering the best price of .65 cents per output line for Re-indexing Services of Recorded Land Instruments for the Plymouth County Registry of Deeds. Commissioner Wright seconded.

Vote: The motion passed unanimously.

#### Registry of Deeds

Register of Deeds Buckley reviewed the monthly financial reports with the Commissioners and reports the deeds excise fees are up this year compared to last year.

#### PCOT-Plymouth County OPEB Trust

Treasurer O'Brien announced the City of Attleboro has joined the PCOT program whose membership has now grown to 17 governmental entities within Plymouth, Norfolk, Bristol and Barnstable Counties.
