A regular meeting of the Plymouth County Commissioners was called to order at 9:06 a.m. at the Plymouth County Commissioners Office, 11 S. Russell Street, Plymouth, MA. Present were Chairman Daniel A. Pallotta, Commissioner Sandra M. Wright and Commissioner Gregory M. Hanley. Chairman Pallotta called for the Pledge of Allegiance.

After much discussion on both sides the Commissioners requested the State delay awarding the RFP and allow the County to rectify the situation.
